Internationalisation of Education

Incoming Mobility in the Netherlands

We work closely with Dutch Higher Education Institutions to increase the quality and diversity of Indonesian students coming to the Netherlands. We organise a variety of events, such as the Dutch Placement Day, Holland Scholarship Day, Students Meet ups, Parents and Teachers Gathering, and Pre-Departure Briefing to prepare Indonesian students to study and live in the Netherlands.

We promote research opportunities together with the Dutch Research Council (NWO), the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW), Academic Transfer and Euraxess.

Since 2012 the MBA Tour has been trusting us to handle the promotion for their annual education events in Jakarta, Bangkok and Manila aiming at providing potential MBA students an opportunity to meet and interact with top business school around the world.

Outgoing Mobility to Indonesia

To stimulate outbound student mobility from the Netherlands, we encourage Dutch students to gain more international experience in Indonesia. We enthusiastically support Indonesian higher education institutions in promoting their international degree programs, short courses, exchange programs and internships by organising webinars for Dutch students. In 2019 we invited Indonesian Higher Education Institutions to participate at the education fair 'Buitenlandbeurs' in Utrecht. According to data from the Indonesian Ministry of Education and Culture, from 2016 – 2019 the total number of Dutch students in Indonesia is in the top 8 of incoming mobility. We publish information about study in Indonesia on our website since there is no centralised information yet from the Indonesian government about Study in Indonesia.

Facilitate

NL Knowledge in Indonesia

We facilitate institutional cooperation involving the Dutch knowledge sector in Indonesia. In 2013 we initiated a model of a student-centric research project based on real-life business issues, known as 'Living Lab'. A consortium of Dutch and Indonesian universities was set up and in cooperation with corporate and government partners used student project results as starting point for further research and development of tools and practices for both industry and government.

We began with the Living Lab Logistics Indonesia to support the national agendas on logistics both in the Netherlands (Topsector Logistics) and Indonesia (SisLogNas). We continued supporting the Living Lab Water Indonesia, and we are currently supporting the Living Lab Tourism in North Sumatra, focused on the development of sustainable tourism around Lake Toba.

DUTEP (the Dutch Training and Exposure Program) focuses on integrated urban water management and is another example where we coordinate a program which allows different stakeholder interests to be combined. DUTEP provides opportunities for selected staff of the Jakarta Capital City Government (DKI) to spend a period in Rotterdam to learn from best practices and develop ideas for solutions of Jakarta's water management problems, by spending time with corporate, government and knowledge sector DUTEP consortium partners.

Scholarship Programmes

StuNed

StuNed is the pioneer of all our scholarship programme funded by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation. Twenty years of experience in managing StuNed has set the bar for what is referred as a well-managed scholarship programme which made it possible for Neso Indonesia to expand its portfolio with more contracts to implement other scholarship programmes. We have implemented StuNed utilizing three modalities; scholarships for master programmes, short courses and Tailor-Made Trainings. StuNed has generated over 4,600 Holland Alumni and supported more than 90 Indonesian organisations.

OKP

The Orange Knowledge Programme (OKP) merges two preceding programmes, the Netherlands Fellowship Programmes (NFP) and the Netherlands Initiative for Capacity Development in Higher Education (NICHE), into a single integrated approach with the addition of new elements including increased involvement of alumni, attention to cooperation between knowledge organisations, and communication focusing on the presentation of results.



We are mandated to run the portfolio of OKP in Indonesia. Through this programme, Indonesian mid-career professionals have the opportunity to get a scholarship for obtaining a master's degree or having a short course in the Netherlands. Beside promoting OKP for individual scholarships, Nuffic Neso Indonesia also manages OKP for customised group training courses, collaboration projects between knowledge institutions, and alumni activities relevant to development cooperation. We are also responsible for the stakeholder management both for OKP counterparts in Indonesia and the Netherlands, programme monitoring, policy and knowledge development as well as communication and outreach.

SHARE

Since 2015, European Union Support to Higher Education in the ASEAN Region (EU SHARE) is implemented by a consortium of European International Education Agencies (British Council, DAAD, Nuffic, ENQA). We are acting as the project office for Nuffic and we are responsible for student mobility with credit transfer by managing SHARE scholarship and credit transfer system (CTS). We implement the SHARE scholarship programme through short-term (one semester) exchange of undergraduate students from selected universities across the ASEAN region, whereas more than 500 scholarships have been awarded for both intra-ASEAN mobility and ASEAN-EU mobility.

OTS

Orange Tulip Scholarship (OTS) is partial scholarship offered by Dutch Higher Education Institutions, government institutions, or the private sector to provide talented Indonesian students with the opportunity to study in the Netherlands. This programme can be used as a promotional tool that supports and adds value to the general promotion of Study in Holland. We manage and promote this program since 2012.

Holland Alumni Network in Indonesia

Holland alumni in Indonesia are great asset in enriching the bilateral cooperation between Indonesia and the Netherlands. Our Holland Alumni Network includes thousands of Indonesian professionals and grows with more than 500 Indonesian students returning from their studies in the Netherlands back to Indonesia every year. The Holland Alumni Network is very diverse in terms of age, geographical location, academic background and professional expertise.

To create awareness and build a sense of belonging among alumni, we organise activities that focus on strengthening the network and support professional development. We strategically engage Holland alumni with projects, knowledge exchange and trade and investment opportunities. We also organise job fairs that provide Holland alumni with access to career opportunities in Dutch and Indonesian companies.
